Luna Harrison is a local artist working in Dorset. She takes her inspiration from the world around her and particularly likes to paint the animals with which we share our world. She has enjoyed art since a child, but has recently started to paint more and more as her children have got older. Art provides her with a sense of wellbeing and serenity.



Luna uses watercolour which is an immediate medium that requires you be decisive with the painting process and except any mistakes and developments along the way. This makes the production of the final piece exciting, as often it is different from the plan. Luna's paintings are impressionistic and colourful.

Nearly all of Luna's inspiration is found within a small radius of her home, in the local woods and fields, where she spends as much time as possible watching and documenting the seasons changing, revisiting sites to greet familiar plants each year.
