

Colin Moore and Jazmin Velasco

A joint exhibition of works by Dorset artists, Colin Moore and Jazmin Velasco

Colin Moore was born on the Clyde coast in Scotland in 1949. He studied architecture in Glasgow and worked in an architectural practice for thirty years. He has lived in Spain, Venezuela and London before moving to Dorset. Colin paints in oil and makes prints using a multi-block linocut technique. His work is mostly British landscape and often coastal subjects. In recent years he has carried out a number of public mural commissions, notably for Guy's Hospital in London and for a new Hilton Hotel in Bournemouth.
